<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There are a small number of large purpose-built event facilities (venues/stadia e.g. Croke Park, Aviva, RDS, Three Arena, Convention Centre) where it may be possible to have larger gatherings safely. It is proposed that a process of engagement is put in place to consider this. • **It is envisaged that wet bars could typically remain open in level 2, subject to the development of further guidance on protective measures. However, given the current negative trajectory of the disease, and the recent reopening of schools, it is proposed that wet bars should not open for the first time in the current phase until we have seen at least 2 weeks of stabilisation in the disease trajectory. The same caveat applies to the exemption on spectators at outdoor venues with a capacity of >5,000.
