## **Animal Identification and Movement System (AIM)**

The Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine maintains cattle traceability records on a central database known as the Animal Identification and Movement System (AIM). The AIM system is a generic database and maintains data on a number of animal species including cattle, sheep, pigs and horses.

The AIM system records all births, movements and exits (slaughters, live exports or on-farm deaths) in accordance with EU requirements. Accordingly the AIM system maintains comprehensive data on calf births, farm to farm movements, mart movements as well as details of cattle slaughtered in factories and abattoirs, live exports and on farm deaths.

The AIM system provides the facility to trace all bovines from birth to slaughter. The traceability system provides assurances to consumers at home and abroad about the origin and traceability of beef. It protects animal and human health and secures and maintains markets for Irish cattle and beef.

The Irish cattle identification and tracing system has four component parts;

Tagging;

Passports;

On-farm Herd Register [Blue Book]; and

Computerised database.

Under current EU and national legislation, all bovine animals must be tagged within 20 days of birth and the birth details registered on the AIM system within 7 days of tagging.

The On-farm Herd Register is a detailed record maintained by the herd keeper for his Bovine Herd.

### **Online Facilities**

Farmers may carry out a number of activities online including register calves, apply for Certificates of Compliance (to facilitate movement of animals from farm to farm), notify movements and view the Herd Profile using the Department's website at [www.agfood.ie](http://www.agfood.ie).

## **Sheep, Pigs and Equine**

Farmers can now avail of the **online** facility to record the Annual Sheep, Pig and Equine Censuses.

### **Electronic Herd Register**

Farmers may use the AIM database as an on-farm herd register subject to four conditions:

- register with the Department as a customer of [www.agfood.ie](http://www.agfood.ie);
- agree to comply with the conditions of use;
- use the Department's website at [www.agfood.ie](http://www.agfood.ie) to register calves;
- use the Department's website at [www.agfood.ie](http://www.agfood.ie) to make movement notifications in respect of farm to farm movements called Certificate of Compliance.

### **Benefits**

- May stop using the Herd Register section of the "On Farm Register" known as the Blue Book.
- Register a calf birth online.
- Apply for a Certificate of Compliance to move animals from farm to farm.
- Print the Certificate of Compliance.
- View the most recent TB test dates.
- Filter information in respect of tag numbers, test dates, age and sex.
- Check herd profile details and movement of cattle in and out of the herd.
- Obtain historic herd profiles.

### **Animal Remedies**

It is obligatory to retain a record of animal remedies.

## How to register with [www.agfood.ie](http://www.agfood.ie)

## Online Herd Register

### How to sign up to use AIM as your Online Herd Register

If a keeper is using the online AIM facility to register calf births to apply for Certificates of Compliance for animals he is proposing to move or notifying movements into his herd, then that keeper may use AIM as an online herd register and does not therefore have to update the Blue Book with these details.

To sign up to this facility, the keeper should click “**Register for the use of Online Herd Register**” option. This can be found on main AIM facilities screen as illustrated below;

A keeper is responsible for ensuring that the data maintained on the electronic herd register (AIM system) in respect of his/her herd is accurate and complete.

A keeper shall register calf births electronically and apply for and print a Certificate of Compliance to move animals from farm-to-farm electronically. These functions can be carried out online on AIM or using an approved Farm Management Package. If the farm package does not include a Certificate of Compliance facility, this function must be carried out on AIM. In addition, the keeper will use and avail of any changes that may be made to the electronic facilities for the registration and movement of animals in the future.

A keeper shall have access to print facilities to print off a herd profile for inspection and other documents as required.

A keeper using the AIM system as an electronic herd register shall be in compliance with his/her statutory obligations under animal identification and movement legislation.

The Department reserves the right to remove with due notice the electronic herd register facility. The facility may be removed where the Conditions of Use are not complied with, e.g. the keeper, without good reason, continuously uses a paper process where a corresponding electronic facility is available.

Where the facility to use AIM as an electronic herd register has been removed or the keeper opts out of using the facility, the keeper shall maintain an on farm herd register (blue book) in the format required by the Department from that date.

The Department may at a future date use electronic communication (Email) as a means of corresponding with customers, including the provision of official documentation. If a keeper agrees to receive correspondence from the Department by Email at a future date, please complete the Email Address box below. By default 10 animals are shown per page. The other animals in the herd may be viewed by clicking on the Show entries option. The default may be changed to 25, 50 or all tags.

The profile can also be downloaded using the facility highlighted in the red box. You have the following options;

- Copy - choose this option if you want to copy the data to the clipboard in order to paste all of the animals into a Notepad, Word or other document
- Excel – choose this option if you have Microsoft Excel on your computer and want to work on the data in Excel.
- CSV – choose this option if you want a text file with all of the fields separated by commas. This is a common format that some Farm Management Packages may require.
- PDF – choose this option if you wish to print the profile.



The herd profile is sorted by default in **Tag Ascending Order**.

The profile may also be sorted by **Gender**, **Date of Birth**, **Breed**, **Date Moved In**, or by **TB Test Date**. Click on the column heading to sort by that column. For example, click the **TB Test Date** heading once to sort the profile by **TB Test Date** in ascending order (untested animals are at the top). Click the same heading again to sort the profile in descending order (most recently tested animal are at the top).

## Viewing a Retrospective Herd Profile

A retrospective profile is a herd profile on a particular date in the past. This is useful if you wish to see what (or how many) animals you had on a date in the past.

Enter the date in the **Change Profile Date** field by clicking the **Calendar** icon  to the right of the field. Dates are in the format dd/mm/yy. Click the **Update** button and wait for the profile to load. In this example we will enter 31/12/15.

## Compliance Certificate - Movement to a Show

Herd Keeper may choose to create a certificate of compliance to move an animal to a show; it's created in the exact same fashion as above but from the Movement To dropdown, select **Bovine animals to a Show**

When creating a Show Compliance certificate the user must be aware of the following -

- Show Certificate is valid for a maximum of 30 days or as long as animals are in test
- Moved to is not entered onscreen
- Show Certificate may be reprinted and used more than once within the validity period
- Must be signed and presented to the Show Secretary for each show, the show secretary will then forward the cert to the shows Regional Veterinary Office (RVO)
- Show compliance certificate may be used to move animal onwards from show to a new holding, in this case the notification copy must signed by source keeper, show secretary and destination herd keeper .It must now be returned to the shows RVO by the show secretary.

## Check Eligibility of an animal in advance of a move

A Herd keeper has the facility to check the movement eligibility of an animal in advance of a move to either:

- Mart/Holding
- Export (EU rule criteria)

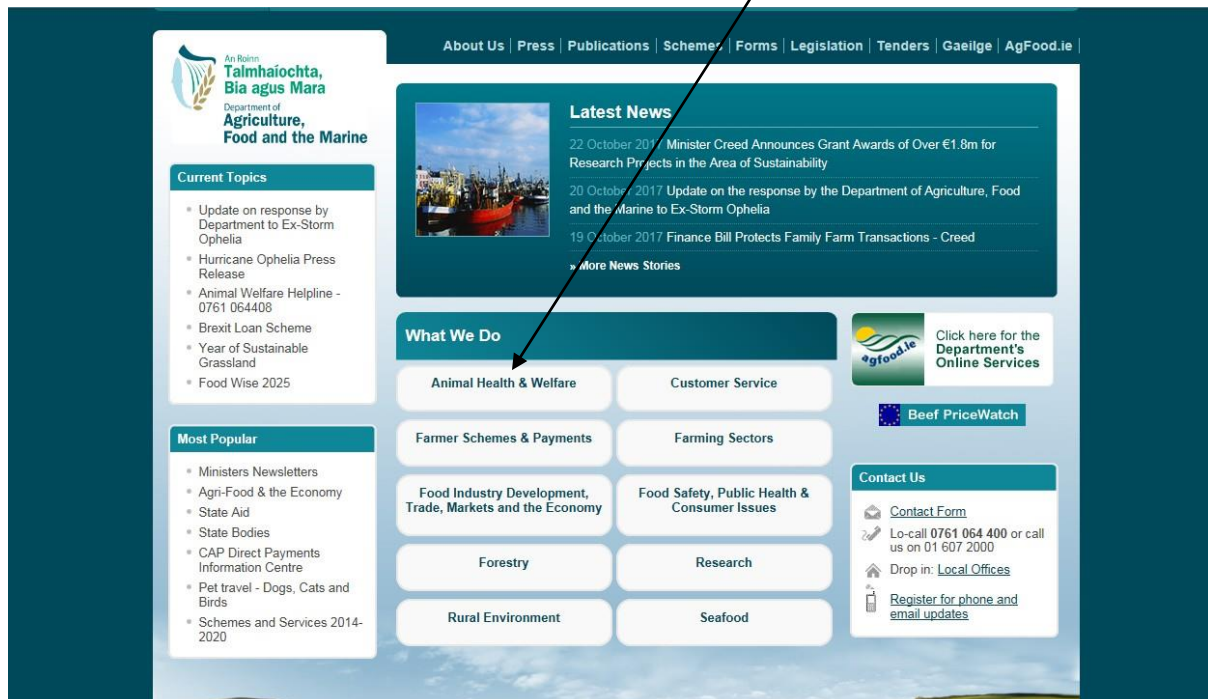

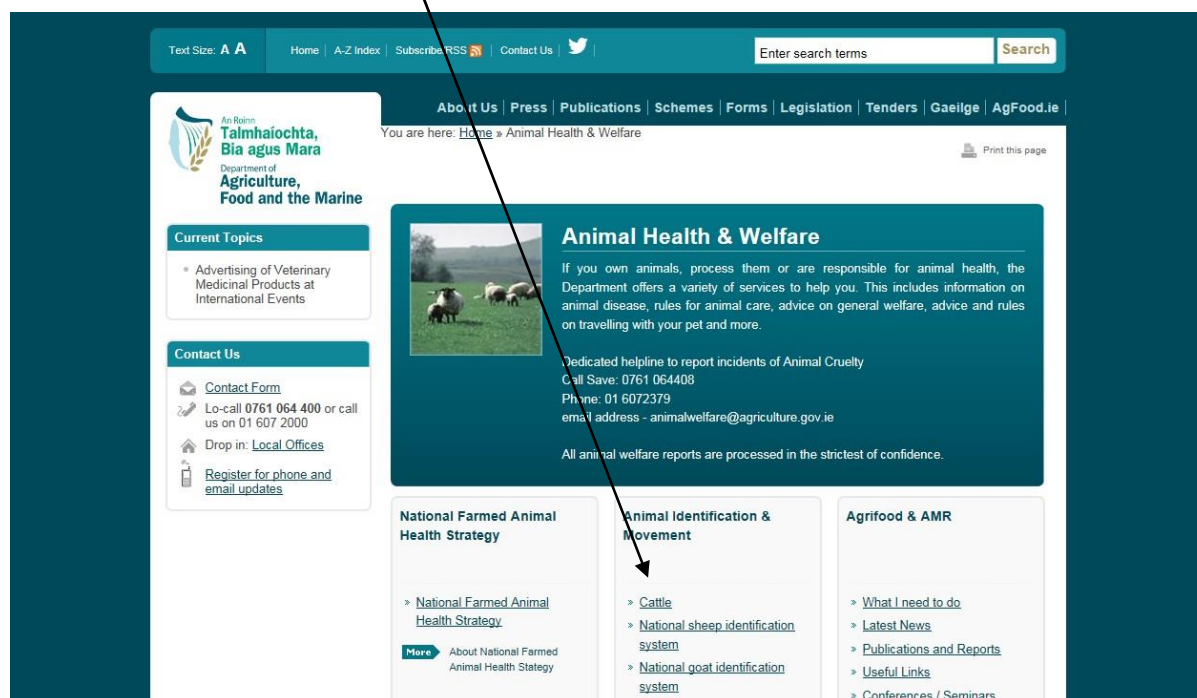

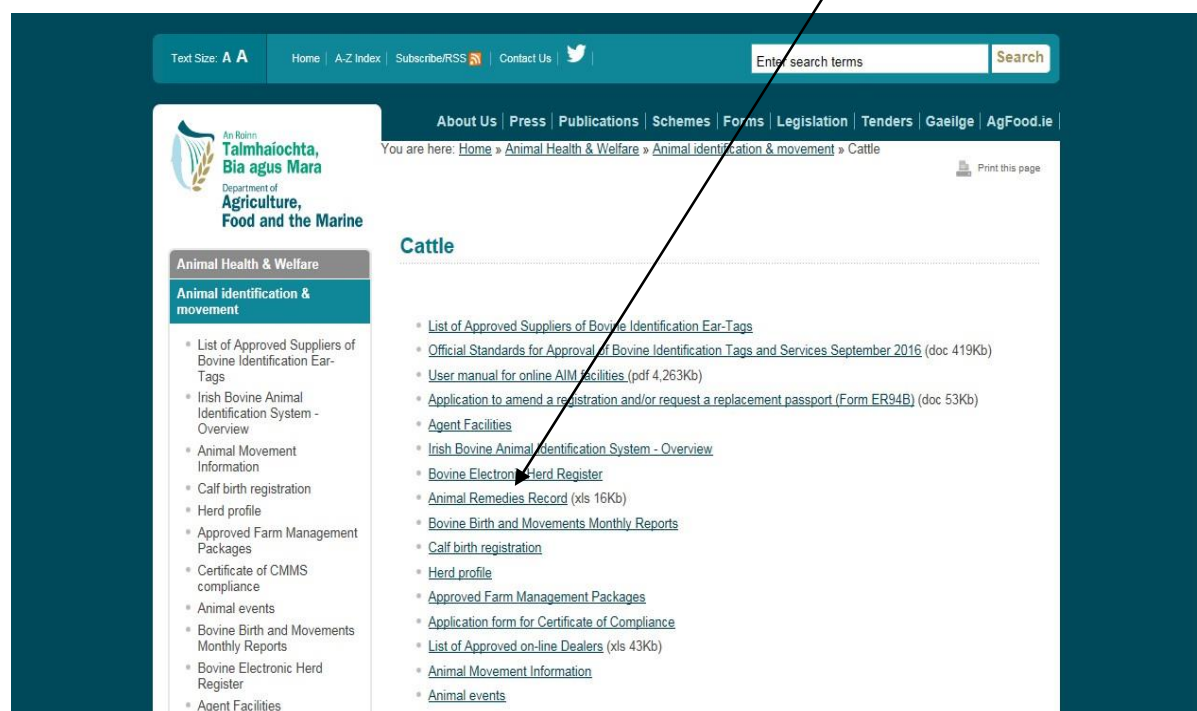
