

Appropriate Assessment Conclusion Statement

Project reference: FS007037 Cork County Council – Maintenance dredging in Ballycotton Harbour, Co. Cork.


The Appropriate Assessment Screening process determined that likely significant effects could not be ruled out with respect to disturbance to species at a number of European sites within the Zone of Influence of the proposed project.

In accordance with Regulation 42(6) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 SI 477 as amended, the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage made a determination following screening that an Appropriate Assessment was required as the project, individually or in combination with other plans or projects, is likely to have a significant effect the integrity of European sites, in view of the said sites' conservation objectives.

Measures to mitigate against the likely significant effects are identified as strict adherence to *Guidance to Manage the Risk to Marine Mammals from Man-made Sound Sources in Irish Waters* (DAHG 2014). This measure will be included as a licence condition. Strict adherence to these measures is considered appropriate mitigation to avoid significant effects on conservation objectives of any European site.

It is therefore determined that the proposed project, either alone or in combination with other projects, will not adversely affect the integrity of any European Site.
