- 45,650 active applications
- Currently matching ACRES application data with BISS 2023 data
- Once data is reconciled application will go through Pre Payment Validation checks
- Payments will issue after application successfully passes PPVs

#### ACRES Circular No. 8/2022 - Conservation of Rare Breeds



Circular sets out clarification in relation to Rare Breeds eligible for ACRES and also clarification in relation to the relevant recognised Breed Societies

- There are a total of 9 types of Rare Breeds allowed in ACRES (4 cattle, 3 horses and ponies, 2 sheep and goats).
- The allowable list of Department recognised Breed Societies are listed on the Circular

#### ACRES Circular No. 13/2022 – Revised Terms & Conditions and Specification –

Circular sets out a number of updates on the T&Cs and also a number of changes to the Scheme Specification, as outlined in Annex 1 of the Circular

- Update on Information and Data Protection
- Update on Payment Rates and Clarification on Rare Breed Progeny
- Clarification on Ranking and Selection Criteria
- Clarification on splitting parcels, Natura, Monuments, Breeding Waders, eligibility requirements, catch crop seed mix, geese and swans, grass margins etc

#### ACRES Circular No. 1/2023 – Amendments to Specification



- amendments made in relation to certified seed being required for the establishments of certain ACRES actions including Catch Crops, Environmental Management of Arable Fallow, Riparian buffer strips/zones, winter bird food etc. Labels and receipts for these actions must be retained.
- Winter Bird Food the minimum seed rate should be at least one third of the monoculture rate for each of the chosen prescribes species for a three-way mix

#### ACRES Circular No. 4/2023 – Amendment to Planting a New Hedgerow Specification

- Participants will be required to plant at least 5 plants per metre in a double row using species shown on the Table in the Circular
- No longer a requirement to plant at least 3 species or to have not more than 85% of one species making up the total

#### ACRES Circular No. 3/2023 - Withdrawal of Actions



A request in writing must be submitted to ACRES operations by the applicant or their representative, formally notifying the department of their intention to withdraw the action from the ACRES contract by email to

or by post to

Depending on whether the withdrawal of the action has implications for the Tierage of the application, penalties may be incurred. The penalty for withdrawing an action that causes the loss of Tier 1 or Tier 2 status is 100% of the ACRES payment for the year of withdrawal

The applicant may be required to pay back all money paid for the withdrawn action from the commencement of the contract up to the point of withdrawal

#### ACRES Circular No. 11.1/2023 Transfer of contracts- Rules



- A participant may only hold one ACRES contract.
- A participant continues to be fully responsible for the implementation of the commitments entered into under the contract for the duration of the contract, unless a request to transfer the ACRES contract has been approved.
- Only a transfer to a Family Member is permitted.
- If a change in herd number is required, this must be advised at time of application for transfer.
- All ACRES commitments and associated land parcels must be included in any application to transfer. A scheme contract may not be divided.

#### ACRES Circular No. 11.1/2023 Transfer of contracts- Rules



- Transfer approval will only become effective, once the transferee becomes the registered Business ID owner.
- BPS/BISS applications must match the herd number on the ACRES contract.
- After the approval of an ACRES transfer no further transfer of the contract will be permitted for a year unless it is due to death of the participant or certified serious illness.
- Following the transfer of the ACRES contract the transferee is liable for a full clawback, including payments issued prior to the transfer, in the event of penalties, including the withdrawal of actions or the entire contract

#### ACRES Circular No. 11.1/2023 Transfer of Contracts- Process



In compliance with the ACRES Terms and Conditions, all ACRES contract transfer requests must be made in advance in writing using the attached 'Request for Transfer of ACRES Contract form. The form must be signed by all parties requesting the transfer and returned by email to:




#### **Low Emission Slurry Spreading**



- Holdings must have a grassland stocking rate of less than 100Kg Nitrogen per hectare from grazing livestock manure prior to export of livestock manure
- All the slurry applied on the farm (produced and/or imported) must be spread by one or a combination of Band spreading, Injection systems or Trailing shoe for each year of the contract,
- Pig slurry is not eligible for payment under this action. Only slurry produced on the holding (excluding pig slurry) is eligible for payment.
- Retain and provide if requested documentary evidence to confirm; the spreading method used, and the volumes spread on the holding. slurry produced, imported, spread and/or a receipt from the contractor or other evidence as required.
- The minimum volume of slurry that must be applied on the holding each year of the contract using one of the above listed methods is 50 cubic metres.
- Farmer or their approved adviser must submit a completed annual slurry declaration return to ACRES section, DAFM, Johnstown Castle. This will be done through an online portal








