Votice is hereby given pursuant to Section 19 of the Foreshore Act, 1933 that Cork Cousty Journell, County Hall, Carrigrothme Rond, Cork, T12 E2NC has applied to the Minister of Housing, Local Government and Heirings for a Coresbore Licence under Section 3 of the said tet for dredging words in Ballycotton Harbour, Co. Cork.

Orik County Council propose to dredge an area adjacent to the main pier in Bailycoiton farbour to bedrock or to 3.5m Chart Datum, whichever is shallowest; freedge remâlader of the harbour adjacent to the breakwater to bedrock or to -2.5m Chart Datum whichever is shallowest.

Disposal of suitable dredged materials at the previously used Dumping at Sea site South of Power Read, 16km southwest of Ballycotton. Disposal of contaminated dredged material will as to a suitably licenced landfill facility.
