

#### CSO and the National Data Infrastructure

- Coordination of the Irish Statistical System across the Civil and Public Service.
- Supports deeper analytics and policy development in public bodies.
- Educational Longitudinal Database statistical framework to analyse learner outcomes from post-primary level to adult education over many years.






#### Timeline of Data Availability

#### **CSO Data Matching Protocol**

- Data collected under Section 30 of the Statistics Act, 1993
- Data matching protocol (https://www.cso.ie/en/aboutus/lgdp/csodatapolicies/csodataprotocol/)
- Access restrictions:
  - Officers of Statistics
  - Access to data sources controlled
- Data minimisation policy
- Transparency data protocol register (https://www.cso.ie/en/aboutus/lgdp/csodatapolicies/csodataprotocol/csodataprotocolregister/)








#### **Cohort Definition**

- Medicine and Nursing & Midwifery graduates
- NFQ level 8 undergraduate programs
- Identified using course name, course code and CAO code

- Can only calculate outcomes for graduates with a PPSN
- Non-Irish students get a PPSN only if they are in employment
- Restrict analysis to Irish graduates




#### Number of Graduates - Medicine






#### Number of Irish Medicine Graduates by Institution





#### Number of Graduates – Nursing & Midwifery








## Medicine Outcomes Nursing and Midwifery Outcomes

#### **Outcome Definitions**

Outcome	Definition
Substantial Employment Only	Min. 12 weeks employment & earning min. €100 per week
Substantial Employment and Education	As above and enrolled in higher education
Education Only	Enrolled in higher education
Neither Employment nor Education	Don't meet criteria above but captured in some data sources
Not Captured	"Presumed" to have emigrated




#### Outcomes for 2010 to 2013 graduates - Medicine




### When do Graduates First Emigrate?

## Number of years since graduation that Nursing & Midwifery graduates are first 'not captured'









## **How Long do Graduates Emigrate for?**

## Number of years Medicine graduates are 'not captured' <u>five</u> years after graduation






## Number of years Medicine graduates are 'not captured' ten years after graduation






## Number of years Nursing & Midwifery graduates are 'not captured' <u>five</u> years after graduation
