Vincent O'Brien of the National Cyber Security Centre gave a presentation about the work of the Centre to counter hybrid and cyber threats Hybrid threats are characterised by coordinated, synchronised action (that can target democratic states by a wide range of means) using conventional and unconventional tactics, in particular through cognitive warfare which can influence decision making, attitudes and behaviours. This can include disinformation and foreign interference and manipulation of information (FIMI).
