Trader Notice No MH 05/2024

To: All Food Business Operators at Approved Meat Establishments

Subject: Resumption of trade and revisions to the agreement on the export of pork/pork products to Malaysia.

Background

Original agreement was reached with the Malaysia authorities for the export of pork/pork products in November 2022. The Malaysian authorities have made a further revision to the eligibility of pork / pork products for export.

Veterinary Health Certificate (VHC)

An additional health attestation has been included (No.6) which states that:

Based on the results of the National Residue Control Plan on harmful substances in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2017/625, pig meat from which products are derived does not contain residues and is free from nitrofurans, beta agonist and chloramphenicol.

Copies of the revised agreed VHC, printed on secure stationery, will be made available on request to certifying officers at eligible plants through the usual channels.
