





# Exchequer deficit of €1,114 million.






#### End March 2018 gross receipts vs profile and year-on-year










## **Non-Tax Revenue and Capital Resources**



 Non-tax Revenue of €107 million was up 43.9% or €33 million year-on-year, due to carbon credit auction revenues.




• Capital Resources of €958 million, were almost flat, down 0.6% of €6 million year-on-year.







## Gross voted current expenditure of €13,340 million










## **Non-Voted Expenditure**



- €2,143 million to end Q1
  - €6 million (0.3%) below profile
  - €142 million (7.1%) up year-on-year.



- €813 million to end Q1
  - €17 million (2.1%) above profile
  - €141 million (21.0%) up year-on-year due to an increased EU Budget Contribution.

- Total Non-voted Expenditure of €2,956 million
- €282 million (10.6%) up y-o-y
- €23 million (0.7%) above profile





## Summary

- Exchequer deficit of €1,114 million, up €211 million year-onyear but €251 million better than profiled.
- Tax revenues of €11,952 million up 3.5% year-on-year and down 1.2% on profile
- Gross voted expenditure on public services and infrastructure up 3.7% year-on-year and down 2.3% on profile.
- Stability Programme Update to be published later this month.
