The European Commission set up EURES to make it easy for workers to move employment in the European Union (EU) and European Economic Area (EEA) countries.

In Ireland, the European Employment Services of the Department of Social Protection coordinates EURES. At European level, EURES:

- is a cooperation of public employment services in all EU/ EEA countries
- comprises more than 900 specially trained European EURES Advisers
- maintains a European database of employment opportunities
- hosts a CV database of European jobseekers
