Investigation Report

General information

- 1. The deceased was a 64 year old man who came from the Western Region.
- 2. He is survived by his extended family.
- 3. The deceased was committed to Castlerea Prison on 14 July 2015 with a remission date of the 13 April 2019.
- The deceased was granted reviewable temporary release on 18 November
 2015 on compassionate grounds due to his maximum dependency care needs.
- 5. He abided by the conditions of his temporary release.
- 6. He died on 6 October 2017 following emergency admission to University College Hospital Galway.

Findings

- 7. I am satisfied that the granting of Reviewable Temporary Release to the deceased was appropriate having regard to his medical condition.
- 8. His cause of death is a matter for the Coroner.
- 9. I am satisfied that there are no further issues which I should investigate.
