## **DECLARATION BY BENEFICIARY**

"I/We understand that in accordance with the European Union Guidelines for state aid in the agriculture and forestry sector and in rural areas 2014 − 2020 data of beneficiaries of funding under the Forestry Programme 2014 − 2020 will be published and may be processed by auditing and investigating bodies of the European Union. This information will be published on the Department's website and will include the full text of the notified aid scheme and its implementing provisions, the granting authority, the names of the individual beneficiaries, the form (in particular the aid instrument) and amount of aid granted to each beneficiary, the date of granting, the type of undertaking (SME/ large enterprise), the region (at NUTS level II) in which the beneficiary is located and the principal economic sector in which the beneficiary has its activities, at NACE group level. - Data provided to Forestry Division of the Department are accessed by the Department's Accounts
  Division in order to facilitate the making of payments to you. The Department is also obliged by law
  to provide information concerning applicants in response to requests received from the office of the
  Revenue Commissioners, An Garda Siochána and other bodies in accordance with current Data
  Protection legislation. The Department does not transfer personal data in relation to forestry
  schemes outside the EU.
- The data collected for the purpose of processing payments will be held by the Department for as long as there is a business need to do so in line with the purpose(s) for which the data was collected. After this time, the data will be marked for destruction and destroyed in accordance with internal guidelines or guidelines for destruction set out by the National Archives Office or associated permissions received from that Office.
