1. Update from NPHET

- The Chair provided an update on the current status of the group's work. She thanked the members for their swift responses and for convening for the second time in the week.
- The Chair advised of other work ongoing by NPHET, including the establishment of a National Research Ethics Committee to expedite COVID-19 related work. She indicated that research calls for projects on the pandemic had gone out the previous evening.

2. Ethical Framework for Decision Making in a Pandemic

- The Chair thanked the group for their input into the Ethical Framework.
- She advised that the Framework had been due for publication the previous evening but would now be published that evening.
- The Chair informed the group that NPHET were clear on the importance of the Framework being released to support healthcare workers.
