

- In order to be authorised as a Meat Feeder, the applicant must comply with the European Communities (Animal By-Products) Regulations 2014 (S.I. No. 187 of 2014), Regulation (EC) No. 1069/2009 and Regulation (EU) No. 142/2011.
- 'CN24B Ministerial Conditions for Authorised Persons ('Meat Feeders') of Meat ABP (Animal By-Products) Greyhounds' can be found here and must be read before completing this application form.
- See attached Data Protection Notice 'DPN 1– Meat Feeder Licences Greyhounds' (Appendix 1).
- **Please note:** The application form must be completed by the 'operator'. The operator is defined as 'the natural or legal persons having an animal by-product or derived product under their actual control, including carriers, traders and users'.

Data Protection Notice

Part A:

Information applicable to all Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine customers:

7. Rights of the individual in relation to personal data held by the Department:

8. Specified purpose:

The requested data is needed to enable the Department to issue a meat feeder licence to the applicant.

9. Legal basis:

Under Regulation 3(3) of SI 187 of 2014 the Minister may authorise the use of animal byproducts for special feeding purposes (dogs from recognised kennels or packs of hounds including greyhounds).

10. Recipients:

The data is sent to the Irish Coursing Club who issue a recommendation to the Department to grant a meat feeder licence.

11. Transferred outside the EU:

Not applicable.

12. Retention Period:

The data collected will be held by the Department only as long as there is a business need to do so in line with the purpose(s) for which it was collected. After this time it will be marked for destruction and will be destroyed in line with internal guidelines or guidelines for destruction received from the National Archives Office or associated permissions received from them.

13. Data provision being statutory or contractual obligation:

The data provided is being requested under the requirements of Regulation 3(3) of SI 187 of 2014 and if the customer chooses not to provide this information their application for a meat feeder licence cannot proceed.
