- The operator must comply with the European Communities (Animal By-Products) Regulations 2014 (S.I. No. 187 of 2014) and in accordance with Regulation (EC) No. 1069/2009 and Regulation (EU) No. 142/2011.

- All personal data processed by the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine
