

CN:30 Conditions for the use of Fish ABP as Fish Bait

MINISTERIAL CONDITIONS FOR AUTHORISED PERSONS TO USE FISH ABP (ANIMAL BY-PRODUCTS) AS FISH BAIT

- 1. Fish ABP to be used as fish bait may only be purchased for feeding by an authorised operator.* Each authorisation must be in date.
- 2. Fish ABP may only be accessed or purchased from approved premises listed on the Department of Agriculture, Food & Marine website maintained by the ABP Section, Milk & Meat Hygiene/ABP/TSE Division, Department Of Agriculture, Food & the Marine.
- 3. On each visit to purchase the Fish ABP, the operator must present his/her authorisation.
- 4. All Fish ABP should be stored appropriately. Storage should consider the risks posed to the fish being fed such as contamination of the Fish ABP with other products. The Fish ABP should be maintained suitably frozen or chilled if not fed immediately.
- 5. Measures should be taken to avoid nuisance deriving from pests or odour associated with the activities involving Fish ABP on site.
- 6. Fish ABP must be stored, secured and fed appropriately, ensuring that children or unauthorised persons and animals other than those for which the authorisation is held may not access the Fish ABP.
- 7. The Fish ABP storage areas, feeding areas and all associated utensils and equipment must be correctly maintained and cleaned.
- 8. The operator must comply with all relevant requirements listed in national legislation and EU Legislation (Regulations (EC) No. 1069/2009 and Regulation (EU) No. 142/2011).

^{*&#}x27;Operator' means the natural or legal persons having an animal by-product or derived product under their actual control, including carriers, traders and users.
