1.1 Description of proposed works/activity.

This application is for marine site investigation works associated with the construction of a proposed waste water treatment plant in Whitegate - Aghada. This treatment plant will include the construction of a sea outfall, approximately 500 metres long.

Ground Investigation

It is intended to undertake geotechnical marine based site investigation, in the form of:

- o The installation of No. 6 boreholes using cable percussion and rotary core drilling, the location of which can be found in drawing number IW-10015229-03-04-001.
- o A geophysical survey using seismic reflection and refraction. The area to be surveyed is shown in drawing number IW-10015229-03-04-001.
- o No. 5 Benthic grab samples. Grab samples obtain a sample for sediment analysis.

The results of these works will provide a greater understanding of the benthic (sea floor, the sediment surface and sub-surface layers) and bedrock character along the proposed outfall route from the proposed Wastewater treatment plant.
