FARM HAZARDOUS WASTE BRING CENTRES

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has teamed up with Feapac, the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine, Local Authorities, WEEE Ireland, European Recycling Platform (ERP) Environmental Ltd to operate ten bring centres for the collection of farm hazardous waste during October and November 2014. This pilot scheme provides farmers with an excellent disposal of their hazardous wastes in a manner that protects human health, livestock and the environment.

Waste types accepted	Cost
Out of date pesticides and biocides; veterinary medicines and animal health care wastes; needles and syringes; waste paints, aerosols, corrosives (acids, detergents), oil and air filters; oily wastes; brake fluids; brake pads; antifreeze; adhesives; coolant	€8.11 (excl. charge)
Waste packaging e.g., plastic and/or metal containers that are contaminated with hazardous materials	€8.11 (excl. p)
Waste engine oil and waste hydraulic oil (do not mix with vegetable oil)	Free
Waste electronic and electrical equipment (WEEE) (e.g., TVs, computers, fridges, freezers, power tools, printers, all batteries and light bulbs)	Free

Important Information

- ▶ Each waste type must be clearly identifiable, segregated and packaged to avoid leaks.
- ▶ Wastes can **NOT** be dropped off **BEFORE** or **AFTER** the designated collection day.
- ▶ MIXED wastes will **NOT** be accepted.
- ▶ Farm plastics such as silage wrap, fertiliser and feed bags; netting, and triple rinsed pesticide containers will **NOT** be accepted.
- ▶ All needles and syringes to be delivered to the centres in separate sealed containers.
- ▶ Payment by cash, cheque or card.
- ▶ Farmers will be issued with a receipt of payment and a certificate of transfer of control of waste.
