The volume and type of material to be excavated is estimated as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gravel: 10,894m³ • Silt: 2,880m³ • Sand: 2,984m³ • Rock: 1,260m³ <p>Subject to the quality of material dredged, it is estimated that 1,260m³ of rock, and 3,410m³ of gravel will be placed behind the new quay wall to fill the void created.
