## LICENCE UNDER SECTION 3(3) OF THE FORESHORE ACT, 1933

The Minister for Housing, Planning and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 3(3) of the Foreshore Act, 1933 (No. 12 of 1933) and in consideration of the sum of the licence fee which has been paid in recognition of the rights and interests of the State in the foreshore concerned, hereby authorises Castlegregory Race Committee, c/o Raymond Sugrue, Farmsbridge, Tralee, Co. Kerry (hereinafter referred to as "the Licensees"), to use and occupy that part of the foreshore at Stradbally beach, Castlegregory, Co. Kerry for the purpose of holding horse and pony races thereon.

## The Licence is granted on the condition that:

- 1. This licence shall have effect on Sunday, 23 June 2019, for the term of one day only.
- 2. The Licensee shall use that part of the foreshore at Stradbally, Castlegregory, Co. Kerry, the subject area of this licence, for the purposes as outlined in the application and for no other purpose whatsoever.
- The activity works shall be carried out within the area delineated in red on OSI Place Map ITM Co-Ordinates 458496, 613500 and annexed hereto (Schedule 1).
- 4. The activity shall be conducted in accordance with the application submitted to, and approved by, the Minister.
- 5. The Licensee shall at all times during the continuance of this Licence ensure that the activity are conducted in a manner that is to the satisfaction of the Minister and that it will not be injurious to navigation, the adjacent lands or the public interest.
- 6. The Licensee shall ensure that the minimum area of access routes to the activity site is utilised, so as to reduce the impact of the proposed activity.
- 7. The Licensee shall schedule the activity so as to minimise disruption and inconvenience for other users of the foreshore.
- 8. The Licensee shall pay to the Minister the sum of on the signing hereof.
- The Licensee shall indemnify and keep indemnified the State and the Minister, their
  officers, agents and employees against all actions, loss, claims, damages, costs, expenses



and demands arising in any manner whatsoever in connection with the said works or in the exercise of the permission hereby granted.

- 10. The Minister shall be at liberty at any time to terminate this Licence by giving to the Licensee notice in writing and upon determination of such notice the Licence and permission hereby granted shall be deemed to be revoked and withdrawn without any liability for the payment of compensation by the Minister to the Licensee.
- 11. The Licensee shall, if so required by the Minister after receipt of such notice, or on the termination of this Licence from any other cause, at its own expense remove any or all equipment in connection with the said activity to the satisfaction of the Minister, and if the Licensee refuses or fails to do so the Minister may cause the said equipment to be removed and shall be entitled to be paid by and to recover from the Licensee as a civil debt due to the State, all costs and expenses incurred by him in connection with such removal.
- 12. In the event of breach, non-performance or non-observance by the Licensee of any of the conditions herein contained the Minister may forthwith terminate this Licence without prior notice to the Licencee.
- 13. Any notice to be given by the Minister may be transmitted through the Post Office addressed to the Licensee at its last known address.

## And on specific condition that:

- 14. An adequate safety plan shall be in place for the event as required under the Health, Safety and Welfare at Work Act, 1989, and all necessary precautions shall be taken in conjunction with Kerry County Council, An Garda Siochána and Civil Defence to safeguard the public coming to, attending and leaving the races.
- 15. A traffic management plan shall be agreed between the organisers and An Garda Síochána and a copy of the plan shall be submitted to the Senior Engineer of Kerry County Council in advance of the event.
- 16. No mechanically propelled vehicles or horse drawn trailers other than ambulances, Garda, Civil Defence and Red Cross service vehicles and such vehicles as are necessary in connection with the running of the race meeting shall be allowed onto the foreshore.
- 17. No bookmakers, amusements or traders shall operate on the foreshore.





- 18. No horses other than those being used in connection with the race meeting shall be allowed onto the foreshore.
- 19. The area over which it is intended to run the races shall be fully cordoned off and all spectators kept on the landward side.
- 20. The cordon shall be of a substantial nature and be adequately stewarded.
- 21. The Licensee shall provide a fence enclosure adjacent to the finish line to protect the public.
- 22. The Licensee shall arrange with Kerry County Council's Area Engineer to have an adequate number of litter bins in place and all litter, et cetera collected from the beach immediately after the races and disposed of at the nearest Waste Disposal Site.
- 23. No maltreatment of or cruelty to participating animals shall arise as a result of these races.
- 24. The Licensee shall arrange to have a duly qualified Veterinary Surgeon in attendance in an official capacity for so long as any horses and ponies are present on the foreshore on the day in question.
- 25. No horses shall be allowed onto the sand dunes.
- 26. The Licensee shall ensure that applicable beach bye-laws are complied with.
- 27. The Minister and Department of Housing, Planning and Local Government and the Minister and Department for Finance shall be indemnified against any claims that may arise in connection with the use of the foreshore.
- 28. Temporary signs shall be erected at the main access points to the beach notifying the general public of the event and any restrictions which apply on the foreshore. All signs shall be removed, after the cordons are removed, on the day of the event.
- 29. The foreshore shall be returned to its original state immediately after the event, ahead of the incoming tide.
