- A vibrant historical and cultural area.

The practical implementation measures for how this can be achieved:

- Zoning as an area of Historical conservation/ 1916 Battlefield Heritage Site
- Board set up similar to Temple Bar renewal.
- Detailed Plan developed and implemented.
- **Pedestrianised:** Moore Lane, Henry Place and the O'Rahilly Parade.
- Uncover the cobbles that bore the boots of the retreating 300 volunteers.
- Trails that link the GPO through Moore Street and up to new cultural quarter
- Create a linear garden to the rear of 10- 25 Moore Street and bounded to the rear by the buildings fronting onto Moore Lane.
- Living over the Shop, mix of Artisan shops, cafes, craft and Galleries.
- Artist and Writers residences, studios, Cultural centres
- Historical trails
- Restoration and sympathetic sensitive infill building.
