Hello Captain Donnelly,

Thank you for this update. I understand from this correspondence with the Sea Fisheries Protection Authority, that fishing vessels will not be operating in the area of Dumpsite A2 (as defined in Schedule A.3 of permit S0015-02) whilst dumping activities are taking place there. I therefore re-authorise Drogheda Port Company to use Dumping site A2 under Condition 3.11 of Dumping at Sea Permit S0015-02:

"3.11 Clean sand loaded from Loading Area A: Seaward Approaches shall be dumped at Dumping Site A2. When access to Dumping Site A2 is restricted due to tidal or weather conditions, this material shall be permitted to be dumped at Dumping Site A 1"
