LICENCE UNDER SECTION 3(3) OF THE FORESHORE ACT, 1933

The Minister for the Environment, Community and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 3 (3) of the Foreshore Act, 1933 (No. 12 of 1933) and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty seven euro (€127) which has been paid in recognition of the rights and interests of the State in the foreshore concerned, hereby authorises Glenbeigh Festival Committee (hereinafter referred to as the Licensee) to use the foreshore at Rossbeigh Beach, Glenbeigh, Co Kerry for the purpose of holding race meetings thereon.

This licence shall have effect on the 22nd and 26rd of August 2015 only;

1. The Licensee shall take all necessary precautions in conjunction with the Garda Síochana to safeguard the public coming to, attending and leaving the races.
2. The Licensee shall ensure that a competent Safety Officer shall be appointed for each day of the races.
3. The Licensee shall arrange with Kerry County Council's Area Engineer, to have an adequate number of litter bins in place and emptied daily and all litter collected from the beach immediately after the races.
4. The Licensee shall indemnify the Minister for the Environment, Community & Local Government and the Minister for Finance against any claims that may arise in connection with the use of the Foreshore.
5. No maltreatment of or cruelty to participating animals shall arise as a result of these races.
6. The Licensee shall arrange to have a duly qualified Veterinary Surgeon in attendance in an official capacity for so long as any horses, ponies or greyhounds are present on the foreshore on the days in question.
7. No mechanically propelled vehicles or horse drawn trailers other than ambulances, Garda, Civil Defence and Red Cross service vehicles as are necessary in connection with the running of the races, which are authorised by the Licensee, shall be allowed onto the foreshore.

8. No bookmakers, amusement or traders shall operate on the Foreshore.
9. No animals other than those being used in connection with the races shall be allowed onto the foreshore.
10. No horses shall be allowed onto the sand dunes.
11. The area over which it is intended to run the races shall be fully cordoned off and all spectators kept on the landward side. The cordon shall be of a substantial nature and be adequately stewarded.
12. The Licensee shall ensure that the aforementioned foreshore shall be cleaned and restored at the end of each day; this work shall be completed ahead of the incoming tide.
13. The Licensee will erect, or cause to be erected, at the entrance, a sign, in appropriate size and form capable of being read by the general public, to the effect that the Licensor (The Minister for the Environment, Community & Local Government) and the Licensee, will not accept responsibility for damage or loss to the users of the premises or to their property, howsoever caused.
