

## **TRADER NOTICE No. 3 OF 2017**

To: All registered exporters of plant and plant produce

**Subject: Revised procedures for issuing replacement Phytosanitary Certificates** 

With effect from 12<sup>th</sup> June 2017 all applications for <u>replacement</u> Phytosanitary Certificates for the exports of plant and plant produce originating in Ireland to non European Union countries, must be accompanied by the original Phytosanitary Certificate and its copy.

Please note that all applications for Phytosanitary Certificates should continue to be submitted to the following email address: <a href="mailto:plantimports@agriculture.gov.ie">plantimports@agriculture.gov.ie</a>, however requests for replacement Phytosanitary Certificates will not be processed until the original Phytosanitary Certificate has been recorded as being returned.

All Phytosanitary Certificates being cancelled or for which a replacement/revised Certificate is being sought must be returned to the following address only:
