

TRADER NOTICE No. 8 OF 2015 to replace Trader Notice 3 of 2015

To: All registered exporters of plant and plant produce

Subject: Revised procedures for submitting applications for Phytosanitary Certificates

With effect from Monday 17th August 2015 all applications for phytosanitary certificates for the purpose of exports of plant and plant produce originating in Ireland to Third Countries outside of the European Union must be submitted on the revised Phytosanitary Certificate Application Form (*ver.2 of 2015*).

Registered Exporters are requested to complete all sections of this form. In the event that a section is not applicable, this should be marked accordingly.

In addition to the revised application form, Registered Exporters of potatoes will be required to complete and return an updated form confirming specific details in relation to the grower and location of the potatoes being exported. This form is only required to be completed once per lot of potatoes to be exported. Subsequent applications for export of potatoes from the same lot shall be referenced in the new phytosanitary application form under variety and field number in box 11 and 16 respectively.
