A message for all Residents in IPAS Accommodation



PLEASE STAY HOME!

Everyone has been asked to stay at home. The same rules apply to accommodation centres – you must stay in the centre and only leave to exercise within 2km, or to go to work in an "essential service", or to attend medical appointments. Go to gov.ie for more information on these rules.



PLEASE STAY APART!

Keep at least 2 metres apart from non-family residents and from staff. Do not stand around in groups.

If you've been advised by a doctor to self-isolate then you must stay in your room where meals will be brought to you.
