Arising from yesterday's meeting of the COVID-19 National Public Health Emergency Team (NPHE), I wish to bring to your attention, as Chair of the HSE NCMT, the following decision of the NPHE which is now required to be actioned by the HSE and Health Protection Surveillance Centre (HPSC):

- The NPHE endorses and recommends the implementation of the HPSC's proposal to rationalise the programme of contact tracing for COVID-19 for those flying into to Ireland;
- The NPHE endorses and recommends the implementation of the HPSC's guidance on visits to and from community homes for people with disabilities.
