Re: Commonages where NO Advisor has applied to prepare a Commonage Management Plan

Applications using the Comm Auth 1 form will be accepted up to **Friday 16th September 2016** from interested advisors. After this time, where no applications have been received, the Department will appoint advisors directly to the remaining commonages.
