Revised Terms and Conditions for GLAS are being uploaded to the website today, which include in Annex 5 the Selection Criteria and scoring to be applied to Tier 3 applications. A copy of Annex 5 is attached, along with an <u>active version</u> of the scoring spreadsheet for your own use. This will allow you to drop in the proposed actions for any Tier 3 application and see the resulting score.

In accordance with the regulations, a pass-mark for Tier 3 applications has been laid down for this Tranche, with a score of 16.3 required. This can be achieved relatively easily: for example a plan for 4 ha of LIPP, 80m of new hedging and 8 bird boxes achieves this score. It should be noted, however, that simply achieving the qualifying score does not guarantee entry into the scheme. With this in mind, advisors are once more reminded of the possibilities of promoting clients from Tier 3 to Tier 2 by selecting one of the key environmental actions identified in the scheme documents, i.e. min till, catch crops, LESS or wild bird cover, provided of course that the minimum required to guarantee promotion is observed.
