



Notification of Application to Conduct Corrib Gas Field Offshore Works 2021

An application has been made to the Department of Communications, Climate Action and Environment to conduct a scope of work at the offshore facilities in the Corrib Gas Field.

This work is due to take place between May and September 2021 subject to regulatory approval, and last for approximately 20 days. The work scope includes

1. Pipeline Inspection and Maintenance of Corrib Assets.

Inspection and maintenance surveys will be undertaken to identify the current condition of the Corrib offshore pipeline and umbilical assets to ascertain any requirement for maintenance works. In addition, inspection of subsea structures will be undertaken at opportune times within the work program.

Visual and acoustic surveys will be conducted by means of vessel/Remote Operated Vehicle (ROV) mounted sensors and cameras located on attendant survey vessels, ROVs and towed Side Scan Sonar.

Pipeline and Umbilical Inspection

The work will be conducted at the Corrib offshore field location (54°20.34′N 11°03.51′W) and will continue toward shore until the vessel is required on Marine Mammal Observer (MMO) advice to relocate to the inshore inspection extent at safe navigation depth limit.

The inshore pipeline and umbilical sections will be inspected from the nearest point accessible inshore at high tide progressing to offshore until a suitable overlap with the offshore inspection is achieved. Landfall is at 54° 17.00′N 09° 49.24′ W.

Vessels


The "Edda Sun", call sign LAR F7, will undertake the offshore scope of work. All equipment used will be vessel and/or ROV mounted.
