

I wish to submit the following for consideration for C.A.P. negotiations:

As an organic Dexter Suckler farmer exclusively I would like to put forward the following points which I think are needed to be considered for the survival of my herd and that of many others into the future.

- A. As a prime beef product with potential to obtain 5.00 to 5.50 a kg at 24-30 months slaughter, being only grass fed with no contamination feedstuffs in that 30 months production.
- B. Easy calving means little or no vetinary/antibiotic inputs.
- C. Out wintering is a must as breed survives all climate conditions.(Canada to Namibia
- D. On small acreage marginal land this breed can survive foraging on all types of grass, new rushes, briars and thistle tops.
- E. Bulls are docile and protective of herd against predators.
- F. With increased awareness of value grass fed beef nutrition 24-30 months. (compared to 16-18 months grain fed housed animals).
- G. Awareness of B12, Vitamin K2, and high marbling of beef, a ratio of fat which is now being recognised as HEALTHY FAT i.e. burns to ketones in body. (Grass fed cattle convert K1 to K2 in their digestive tracts)
- H. Lighter carbon footprint as these animals grow to mass 400kg and don't mark land (poaching), also output of N2 P K less than bigger breeds.(still branded with nitrates levels on par with a 6000kg breed?)

From these points I would appeal for suckler aid for at least f irst 20 cows as they are grazing for years as an ongoing breeding cost, (include bulls). For the survival of this breed as it's a 24-30 month turnover and a bull plus 16 cows on average produce 10-12 calves in 30 month cycle. Non viable considering the cost of setting up a Dexter proof structure / crush, mainly yard, gate structure (multipens) for separation and working sucklers.

Average age of farmers in Ireland: 60 years. Average death rate i.e. accidents: 1 per week

FINANCIAL HELP: Loans going out 8,000euro a year ,10 cattle sold 8,000euro. Plus (insurance ,fencing ,vet testing, tractor repair, planner fees ,organic certification fees ,safety measure fees +++ (a glimpse of the financial cost of setting up a Dexter enterprise) thanks for listening, Martin Heavey
